I have read and agree that I will abide by the following *Code of Conduct* for the **Student Life Mission Trip**. I understand that if I do not abide by the following *Code of Conduct*, I (with a supervising adult) will call my parents for early return home with transportation provided by the parent.

I agree to:

- 1. Respect the health of my own body by refraining from the use of alcohol, tobacco and/or illegal drugs of any kind. Only those drugs prescribed by a physician are acceptable for use.
- 2. Respect the physical and emotional well-being of other youth and adults.

- 6. Abide by group decisions made during the event.
- 7. Stay within the group or the designated sub-group to which I may be assigned. I agree not to wander off. I agree not to leave the activity site unless an adult grants permission.
- 8. Refrain from any public or private display of affection ("Boys are blue, girls are pink NO purple!")
- 9. Refrain from using my cell phone during worship, Bible Study, small group times, and on our ministry site so that my friends, leaders, those at my ministry site and God, will have my full attention.

<u>SPECIAL NOTE REGARDING CELL PHONES</u>: Although they do not pose a problem for some students, for many a cell phone is a distraction that prevents them from fully participating in the events and fellowship of the mission camp. For this reason cell phone use IS NOT ALLOWED during the times noted in item #9 above and any other times specified by youth leaders and accompanying adults. (Phone usage during these times will result in the collection of the phone by youth leaders until the end of the day or such time as the leaders deem appropriate.) Parents can help us by contacting students (if necessary) only before 9am and after 10pm. Parents will be provided with numbers to all adult cell phones in the event you need to reach your child at any other time, and any student who needs to contact parents is welcome to borrow an adult's cell phone. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter.
